<ul style="list-style-type: none">• + Absolute Control• - Maintain Player• - Maintain Storage• - Maintain Delivery• - Manage Encoding• - Manage Bandwidth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• - Less Control• - 3rd party Dependency• + Player Provided• + Storage Provided• + Delivery Provided• + Encoding Provided• + Free bandwidth and CDN

Getting Video into Drupal

Inside Body	Field
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● + User can place anywhere in content● +- User in total control over display● - Expose user to placing <code><iframe></code> or other dangerous elements● - Unable to use in views or teasers nicely	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● + Enforce consistent display across nodes● + Enforce accessibility considerations● + Keeps dangerous elements controlled by developer● + Can be easily referenced in views/teasers● - Difficult to embed into body
